

MAINTAIN LAKE QUALITY

The BLMD was established as a 30-year entity by the Tumwater City Council.

The annual assessment fee was set with a provision in the adopted resolution allowing for inflationary increases over the life of the BLMD. Increases are limited to 110% of the original assesment fees established in 2005.

This is the first proposed fee increase in 15 years due to the inflationary costs of treating the lake.
