

- POST MATERIAL IS TO BE SQUARE TELESPAR PIPE.
- SIGN IS TO BE ON CENTER AND 3" FROM TOP OF BARRIER.
- 3. IN ORDER TO PRESERVE WEATHER PROOFING DO NOT RE-CUT LUMBER ENDS.
- 4. MARKINGS FOR BARRICADE SHALL BE ALTERNATE RED AND WHITE STRIPES (SLOPING DOWNWARD, PER MUTCD, AT AN ANGLE OF 45° TO CURB).
- 5. THE ENTIRE AREA OF RED AND WHITE STRIPES SHALL BE REFLECTORIZED SO AS TO BE VISIBLE UNDER NORMAL ATMOSHPERIC CONDITIONS FROM A MINIMUM OF 1,000 FEET WHEN ILLUMINATED BY THE LOW BEAMS OF STANDARD AUTOMOBILE HEADLIGHTS.
- BARRICADE SECTION SHALL EXTEND TO THE LIMITS OF THE PAVED SURFACE.
