## GRAPHIC ANNUNCIATOR MAP POLICY 01-01 (OCTOBER 1, 2001)

SUBMIT A COPY OF YOUR PROPOSED GRAPHIC ANNUNCIATOR MAP FOR CITY APPROVAL. PLEASE INDICATE ON THE PLANS, HOW THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS WILL BE MET.

- Minimum size of map shall not be less than 8 ½ inches by 11 inches.
- ♦ Map shall be drawn to scale.
- ♦ The graphic annunciator map shall indicate zone / area of alarm activation.
- ♦ The map shall identify wall separation, area separation or occupancy separation by duration (i.e. 1 Hr. 2 Hr. wall).
- ♦ The map shall show each floor level.
- All walls that may interfere with Fire Department access shall be identified.
- ♦ Identify location of Fire Alarm Control Panel(s) using red marking.
- Place a "You Are Here" red spot on the map.
- Building address shall be on map.
- ♦ Identification numbers or letters will be large and easy to read in adverse conditions.
- The numbers or letters shall be as seen on building.
- Lines representing the structure shall be dark and easy to read.
- ♦ The map must be permanent in nature and durable, as well as weather proof, if placed outside.
- The graphic annunciator map shall be submitted for review at time of plan submittal.
