V. P2C Update

The critical issues with P2C appear to have been resolved. It was discovered that during a server migration in March 2015, there was a setting/installation that was missing. Once this was corrected, P2C appears to be functioning properly. Testing is currently underway to confirm.

If this does not resolve the issues, we may need to look into a third-party vendor to accomplish what we're looking for.
